Spirit AeroSystems 2017 Summer Manufacturing Program

In partnership with the Workforce Alliance Youth Employment Project, Spirit AeroSystems is hosting a manufacturing program for students aged 16-19 beginning in early June 2017.

The program, which is structured around select manufacturing processes in sheet metal, composites and machining, will offer students the opportunity to learn about tools and processes while providing hands-on training of some of the critical skills needed to succeed in manufacturing.

There are two separate program paths based on participants' ages:

16-17 year olds

Half-day sessions,
Monday-Friday

18-19 year olds

June 9 - July 27, 2017 (with a one-week
break to observe July 4 holiday)
Half-day sessions, Monday-Friday
